Isaiah 43:1 But now thus saith the LORD that created thee, O Jacob, and he that formed thee, O Israel, Fear not: for I have redeemed thee, I have called thee by thy name; **thou art mine.** 2 When thou passest through the waters, I will be with thee; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow thee: when thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flame kindle upon thee. 3 For **I am the LORD** thy God, **the Holy One of Israel**, thy Saviour: I gave Egypt for thy ransom, Ethiopia and Seba for thee. 4 Since **thou wast precious in my sight**, thou hast been honourable, and I have loved thee: therefore will I give men for thee, and people for thy life. 5 **Fear not: for I am with thee:** I will bring thy seed from the east, and gather thee from the west; 6 I will say to the north, Give up; and to the south, Keep not back: bring my sons from far, and my daughters from the ends of the earth; 7 Even every one that is called by my name: for **I have created him for my glory**, I have formed him; yea, I have made him. 8 Bring forth the blind people that have eyes, and the deaf that have ears. 9 Let all the nations be gathered together, and let the people be assembled: who among them can declare this, and show us former things? let them bring forth their witnesses, that they may be justified: or let them hear, and say, It is truth. 10 Ye are my witnesses, saith the LORD, and my servant whom I have chosen: **that ye may know and believe me**, and understand that I am he: before me there was no God formed, neither shall there be after me. 11 I, even **I, am the LORD**; and beside me there is no saviour.
